FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING AMENDMENTS

SUBJECT: Political Reform Act of 1974: campaign disclosures.

The Committee is hearing AB 14 solely for the purpose of adopting author's amendments. Because these amendments add an urgency clause to the bill, they cannot be adopted without a vote of the committee.

In accordance with Joint Rule 58, the Assembly Rules Committee approved the addition of an urgency clause to this bill at its hearing on April 24, 2017.

The proposed amendments:

- 1) Add an urgency clause, allowing this bill to take effect immediately upon enactment.
- 2) Require the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) to promulgate regulations to implement specified provisions of the bill.
- 3) Provide that all provisions of this bill shall become operative on January 1, 2018, other than the requirement for the FPPC to promulgate regulations, as detailed above.
- 4) Add a co-author.
- 5) Make various technical and corresponding changes.
